

Platform-cooperativism vs. platform-capitalism

work

Alternative experiences in opposition to unfair business models and the precariousness of work

- Founded by users, digital workers & producers to provide a solution to local needs
- Inclusive governance & participatory democracy
- Self-managing / "bossless" platforms
- Fair working conditions
- Avoids displacement of economic value
- Sprit of non-lucrative & social and environmental responsibility
- Produces and protects "commons" (software, knowledge, mobility)

- Co-owners employees with social security
- Social inclusion and identity
- Local partners
- Green Jobs

Type 3: Cooperative-Platform by workers

Social coop (SCIC)

- Diverse stakeholders and community ties
- Public-SSE partnerships

Type 4: Cooperative-Platform by communities





Activity and employment coop (CAE)

- Freelancers as employees with social security
- Mutualization of costs
- Autonomy
